Fellow Residents of Carterville:

Today, Governor JB Pritzker announced he will be extending the Stay Home Executive Order requiring Illinois residents to stay home and continue social distancing through April 30, 2020. With that announcement, I felt it was necessary to update the residents and visitors of Carterville on how this affects City operations.

The offices of Carterville City Hall and Carterville Water and Sewer Department will remain closed to the public but will continue essential operations and see the public in limited circumstances by appointment only. We do have the capabilities of receiving water bill payments online through our city website and have a dropbox on the northeast corner for payment and document drop off.

The City of Carterville playgrounds located at James Street Park and Cannon Park remain closed through April 30, 2020. The Carterville Community Center, Cannon Park Pavilion and the Cannon Park Gazebo are closed to reservations and groups of 10 or more through April 30, 2020. The skate park and Bark Park facilities remain open but social distancing and groups of less than 10 are required. If groups of more than 10 gather and/or physical distancing is not exercised, these areas may be completely closed.

Per the Governor's Executive Order, all non-essential businesses must remain closed through April 30, 2020. The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity released a flowchart that helps delineate essential from non-essential businesses. The DCEO flowchart can be found at www.visitcarterville.com.

To comply with the Stay Home Executive Order and physical/social distancing guidelines, the Carterville Police Department will not be issuing yard sale permits through April 30, 2020.

Information on state and federal small business assistance programs will be posted on the City's website as details are received. Carterville business owners interested in the programs can contact the Carterville Chamber of Commerce or Carterville City Hall.
